

Case Management System Improvements for Integration

- Background:** Since 1997 Coconino County has been developing an integrated criminal justice system to allow law enforcement, attorneys, courts and clerk to share information across varying platforms.
- Funding:** Up to this point funding has been through Federal grants, ACJC and County general fund with resources provided by AOC, Flagstaff Municipal and County Courts. Overall expenditures so far are over \$1M.
- Progress:** Over the past year we have been transferring citation, booking and charging information from law enforcement and jail to the courts, charging information from prosecutors to the courts and disposition information from prosecutors and courts to DPS. We have implemented infrastructure, passed security requirements from DPS, developed messaging systems, input systems and business practices to support this process. - Project:** Currently we are creating more data than the court case management system is able to download. This project would expand the capability of Aztec to accept information flowing through the integration infrastructure.
- Funding:** The overall cost of the project is \$125,000 which will be paid to AOC IT to contract with an outside vendor to make the necessary changes to accept the data. Funding has been committed by City of Flagstaff for \$50,000, Flagstaff Justice Court for \$12,500 and Coconino Superior Court for \$12,500.
