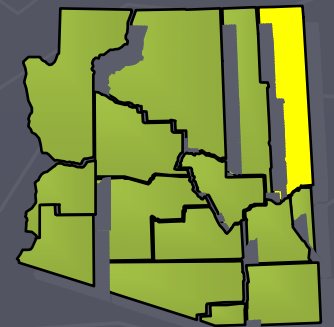

# COT Review/Approval means

- ▶ **Recognizing** in concept the local needs, initiatives and drivers for technology projects.
- ▶ **Approving** projects that clearly conform to existing standards and directions and have sufficient detail.
- ▶ Not approving, but **acknowledging**, general references to projects which are pending future additional information to be provided.
- ▶ **Rejecting** specific projects that appear to run counter to adopted directions and priorities.
- ▶ **Reminding** all courts that referencing a project in an IT plan does not constitute a project investment justification, request for service, or a project plan as required by COT's project methodology.

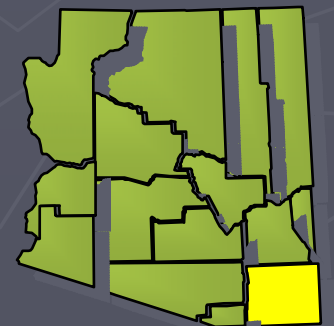
# APACHE COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Strategy: Partner with other clerk's offices to obtain applications and hardware
  - EDMS enhancements, including electronic minute entry/distribution
  - **Court Financials**
- ▶ Indicates Late-adopter status for statewide initiatives



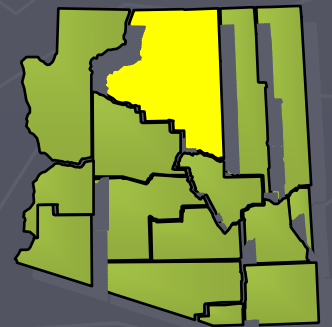
# COCHISE COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Desire dedicated rural support staff
- ▶ Enhancing connectivity between county & court; JOLTS & local justice agencies
- ▶ Installed EDMS
- ▶ Next steps with EDMS
  - Continue to streamline backoffice processes
  - Electronic minute entry distribution
  - Workflow – desire statewide RFP for clerks
- ▶ Improve self help center/public access



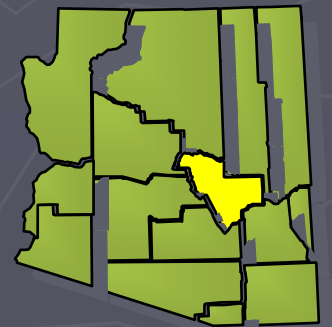
# COCONINO COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Expand Web presence to local courts
- ▶ Continue county-wide integration work
- ▶ Expand use of digital reporting
- ▶ Exploring electronic document management and minute distribution
- ▶ Provide electronic access to microfilmed documents



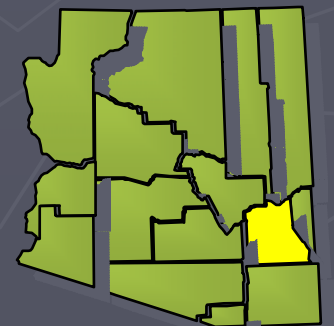
# GILA COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Enhance Web presence, provide more useful information to public for more courts
- ▶ Build own court calendar program to prevent time delays and lessen time to disposition
- ▶ **Submit electronic records on appeal** to Appeals, Div. 2 (e-Blueback)
- ▶ Replace 43 county PCs before APETS implementation
- ▶ Access DPS ACJIS over AJIN



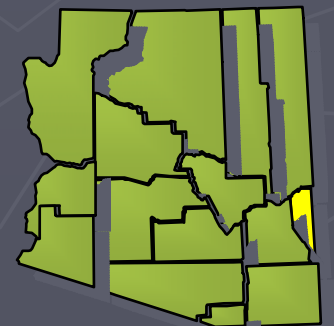
# GRAHAM COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ EDMS next steps with county's LaserFiche system (grandfathered)
- ▶ Improving Data Quality for CPOR & Public Access
- ▶ Increase access to electronic court information
- ▶ **No field trainer and very little IT support**
- ▶ Indicating Late-Adopter for state initiatives



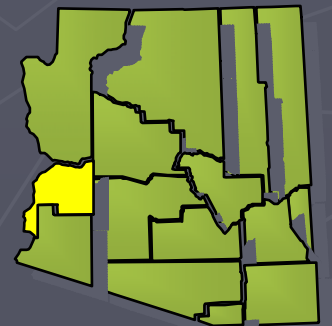
# GREENLEE COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Implement Tax Intercept Program (TIP)
- ▶ Justice integration planning with local agencies
- ▶ Severe need for EDMS/imaging
- ▶ Establish self service area with PC and interactive electronic forms
- ▶ Jury+ upgrade and video recording when funding available
- ▶ Desire "dual use" of ACAP PCs
- ▶ **No longer have field trainer or IT support**



# LA PAZ COUNTY COURTS

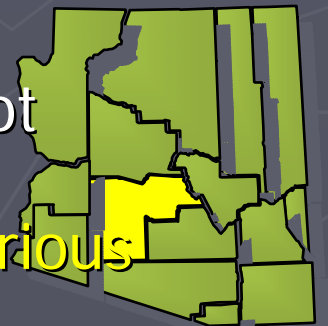
- ▶ Enhance web site with self-help features
- ▶ Implement interactive electronic forms
- ▶ Continue justice integration planning
- ▶ EDMS next steps
  - Backscanning
  - Implement MEEDS
- ▶ **No field trainer in place**



# MARICOPA COUNTY COURTS

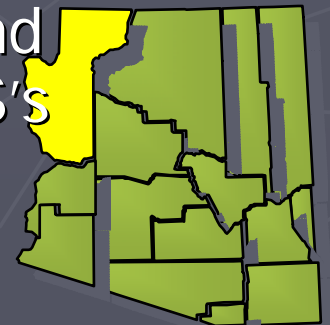
## ▶ Superior Court/Clerk's Plans:

- Continue creation of an integrated technology infrastructure
  - ▶ Integrated financial system
  - ▶ Enhancements to iCIS
  - ▶ New iCIS for justice courts
- Various integration efforts with county continue
- E-filing pilot expansion/model change
- Implement web-enabled interactive forms
- Pursuing online payment method for e-filing and interactive forms generation
- Expand EDMS and create disaster recovery hot site
- **Considering business case for migration of various apps to .NET**



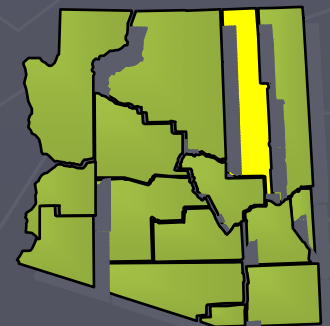
# MOHAVE COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Implemented EDMS
- ▶ Next Steps with EDMS
  - Enhance local workflow processes for all courts
  - Investigate online payments, electronic filing, e-signature
- ▶ Enhance data reporting to and integration with external entities
- ▶ Enhance web sites and expand self-service centers, pursue interactive forms
- ▶ Pursue own external vendor for collections
- ▶ Concern about lack of implementation timeline and perceived lack of integration inherent in new CMS's leading to investigation of alternatives



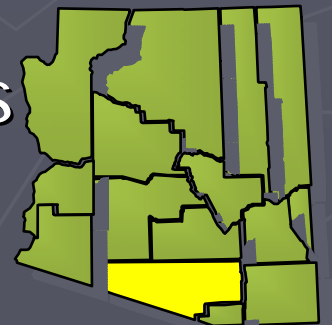
# NAVAJO COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Implementing EDMS
  - Improve case flow processing
  - Wanting electronic minute entry distribution
- ▶ Implement AZTEC file tracking
- ▶ Expand digital audio recording
- ▶ Implement videoconferencing for initial appearance
- ▶ All LJ's participating in FARE
- ▶ Concerned with funding for APETS capable PC's



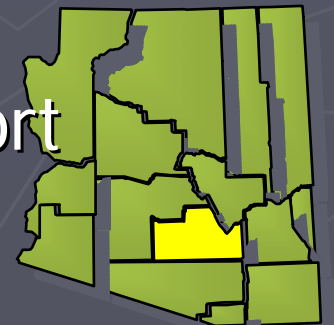
# PIMA COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Develop effective case and calendar management system -- AGAVE
- ▶ Infrastructure improvements continue, technology refresh
- ▶ EDMS next steps
  - Electronic minute entry distribution
  - E-filing pilot expansion (using XML data)
- ▶ Retire outdated computing equipment
- ▶ Tucson anchor tenant for FARE
- ▶ Expand digital recording to all courtrooms
- ▶ Tucson developing handheld e-citation process



# PINAL COUNTY COURTS

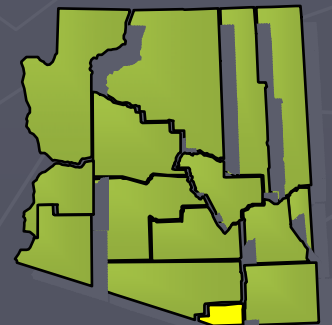
- ▶ EDMS next steps
  - E-Filing with other courts
- ▶ Implement CUBS collections software
- ▶ Expand justice integration efforts
- ▶ Implement FileTracker Bar Code System
- ▶ Jury Plus upgrade
- ▶ Obtain software for functions AZTEC doesn't have – like receivables tracking
- ▶ Use IVR for public access to child support payment and restitution information



# SANTA CRUZ COUNTY COURTS

*Very little new plan data provided this year*

- ▶ Web site enhancements, including jury information and participation
- ▶ Implement JAVS audio/video courtroom recording in superior court
- ▶ Pursue EDMS when funding available
- ▶ Obtain File Tracking and MEEEDS



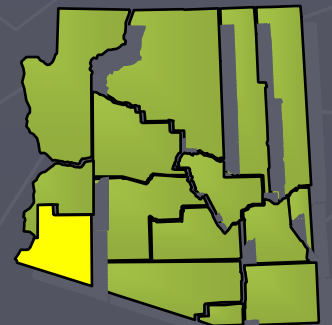
# YAVAPAI COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Create IT Manager position at superior court
- ▶ EDMS next steps
  - Backscan paper documents into EDMS
  - Pursue online payments, electronic filing, e-signature
- ▶ Expand use of audio and video in courtrooms
- ▶ Investigating JOLTSaz calendar for all case types



# YUMA COUNTY COURTS

- ▶ Web site/portal development
- ▶ Jury Plus upgrade
- ▶ New Justice Center facilities
  - Local technology support staff
  - Expanding digital audio recording
- ▶ County/city connectivity for court staff
- ▶ EDMS next step – implement MEEDS
- ▶ Implemented APETS w/ Palm Pilots
- ▶ Migrate legacy case data from AS/400
- ▶ **Concern that EA standards constrain development, keeping courts from selecting “best” solutions**



# COURT OF APPEALS

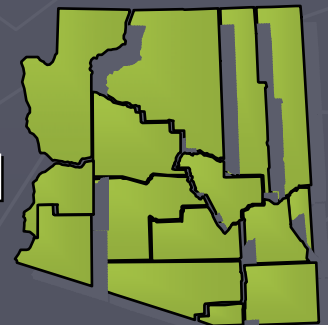
## Division 1 and 2

### ▶ Division 1:

- Continue Appellamation enhancements for e-transfers, EDMS tie-in, and public access
- Implement OnBase EDMS
- **Need plan / Assistance to convert to Word**

### ▶ Division 2:

- Expand scope of existing projects: e-filer, e-Blueback project, e-PR (e-petitions for review to Supreme Court)
- Enhance ODS-Plus EDMS, SIRE, and e-filer applications
- Continue using both WordPerfect and Word together



# SUPREME COURT

- ▶ Continued Appellamation support and enhancement
- ▶ Planning to accept electronic filings from courts
- ▶ OnBase EDMS implementation
- ▶ Portable electronic documents
