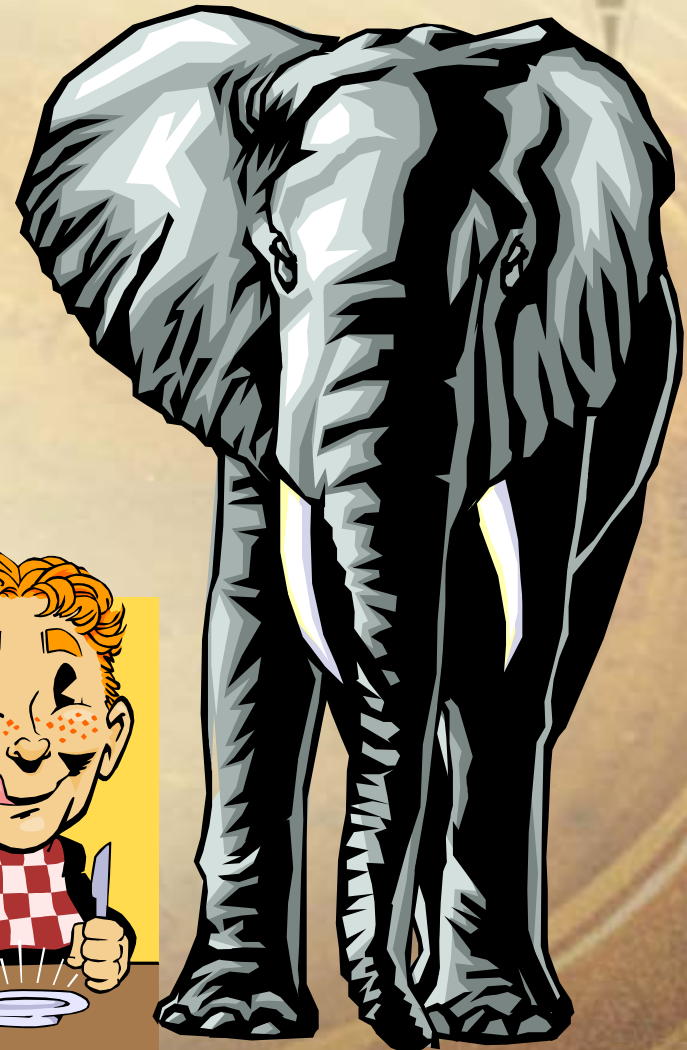
# What is an e-Court?

- **Must be Consistent**

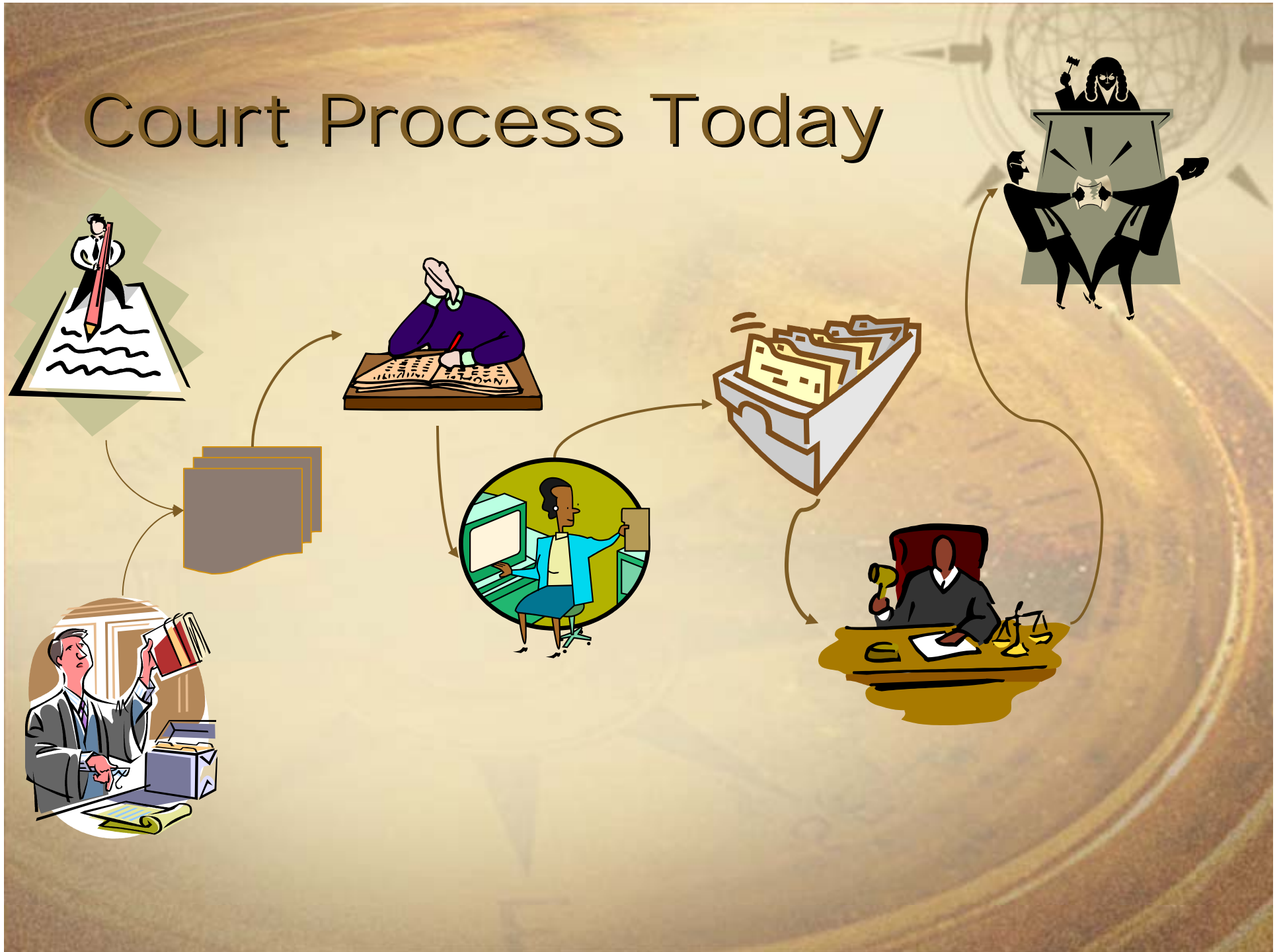
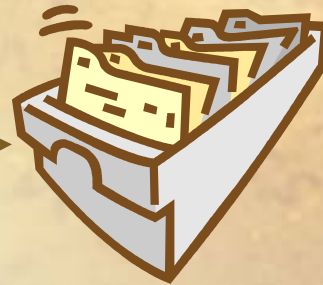


# Evolutionary Approach

- Stick together...there's safety in numbers

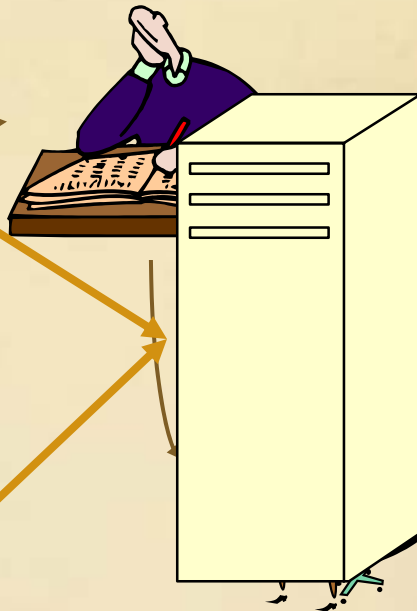

# Court Process Could-Be

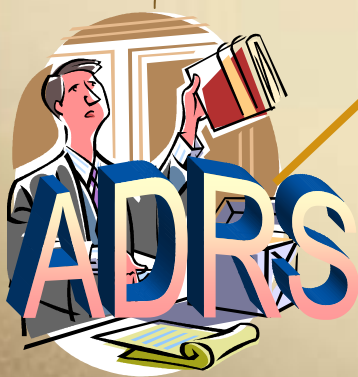

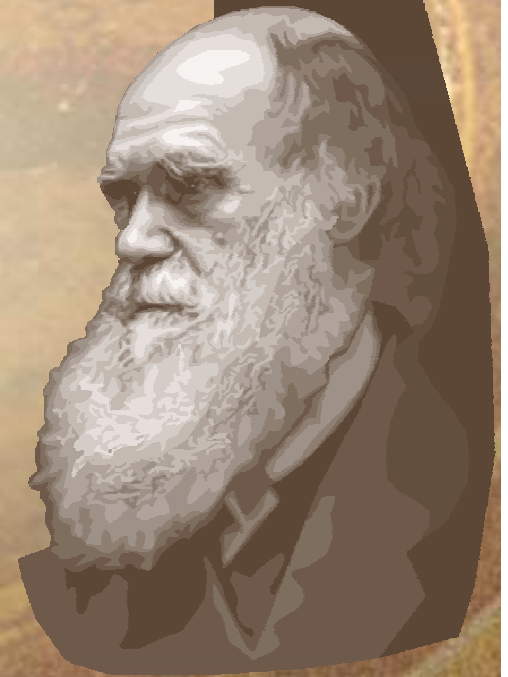

- Phase 1: Court-to-Court

- Phase 3: Public/Bar e-Filing



# Phase 1: e-ppeals & Bindovers

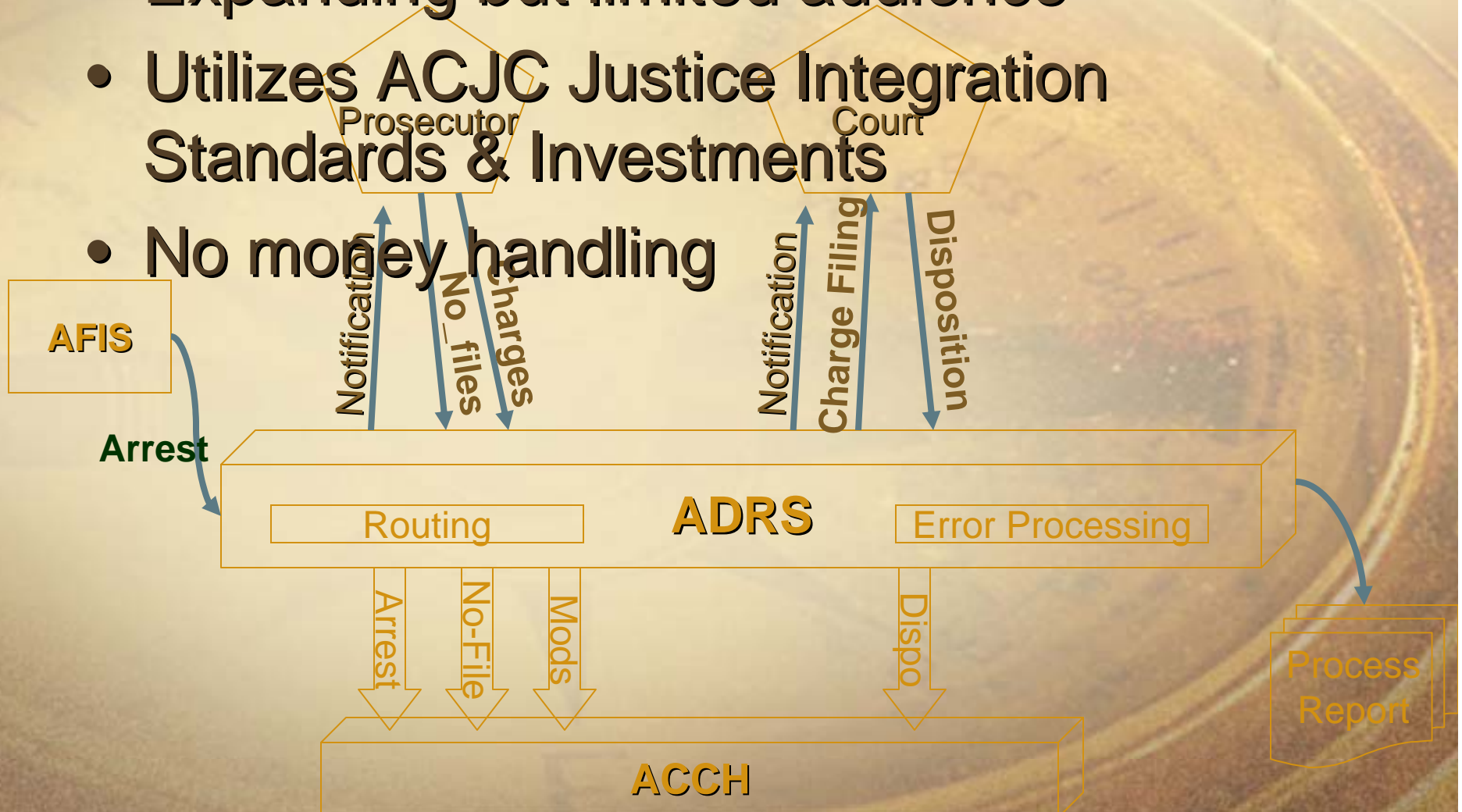
- Keeping it in-the-family

# Phase 2: Prosecutor Filing

- Expanding but limited audience
- Utilizes ACJC Justice Integration Standards & Investments
- No money handling



# Phase 3: Public e-Filing

- Evolves from iForms project
- Assists litigant in forms based filing
- Expands for capture of computer readable filing and fee collection
- Dramatically Reduces Data Entry Workload & Error Rate
- Speeds processing

  - Enable Private Sector Participation/Competition
