APD Legacy Systems move to APETS

- **APETS implementation moves adult probation from four different automated systems and 15 different databases into one system and one single database**
- **APETS enhances each counties ability to track offenders. (Statewide Standard Risk Assessments (OST/FROST), contacts, addresses, conditions of probation, CWS, Treatment, employment, county transfers, etc.)**

JOLTS Systems move to eJOLTS & JOLTSaz

- **eJOLTS and JOLTSaz implementation moves juvenile court, probation, foster care review board and court appointed special advocates into two automation systems**
- **Synchronization of e-JOLTS and JOLTSaz will allow for statewide reporting and analysis of juvenile data**

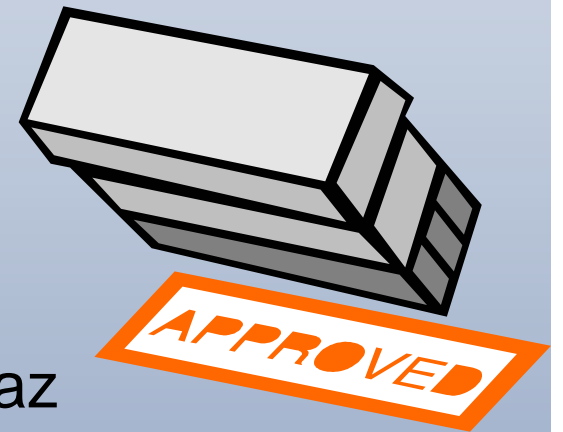

 - Synchronization of e-JOLTS and JOLTSaz

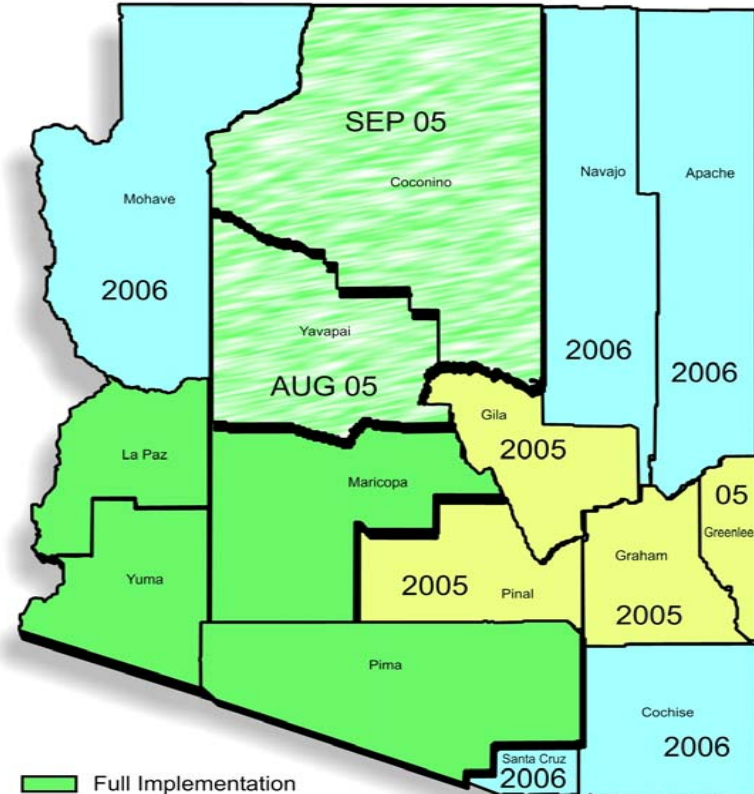
