SUMMARY:
<p>While the new strategic agenda continues to be developed, AOC Education Services Division has extended an opportunity for Karl to address judicial personnel around the state concerning the unprecedented amount of technological change getting underway and the impending impact of technology on court operations. Already, the general jurisdiction case management system is prompting changes in day-to-day practices of court personnel. The limited jurisdiction CMS will follow close on its heels. Statewide electronic filing is also in play and with it the need to store digital documents in every court and provide bench automation to judges. Courts are taking various approaches to the wave of change, sometimes based on rumor or filling in a lack of information. Karl will discuss his outline with members and solicit their input regarding the topics and priorities for the upcoming broadcast.</p>
