**DEFINITION**                        The name of a business as an offender.

**VALID CODES**                        See explanation below.

**FIELD RESTRICTIONS**                **Name of Business as Offender**  
**Type the business name exactly as it appears with no  
punctuation.**

This field is *not* case-sensitive.

Do not include the words "The" or "A" in the title.

If unsure of how to report business name, use printed name in U.S. West phone directory.

***Please note that either an individual's name or a  
business is required.***

For monikers (nick names), don't include a space between words such as "MadDog." When reporting a moniker such as MadDog, the first name is indicated as "X."

<b>FIELD RESTRICTIONS</b>	Only valid codes listed above may be used.

**EXAMPLES** W

**REQUIRED FIELD** Yes

**DEFINITION** This field indicates the race of the offender.

**VALID CODES** W = White  
B = Black  
A = Asian or Oriental  
I = Native American Indian or Alaskan Native  
U = Unknown

**FIELD RESTRICTIONS** If your agency chooses to capture the racial category "Hispanic" separately, the Hispanic category must be included with White before that information is sent to the Central Repository or FBI.

**FIELD RESTRICTIONS**    If the exact date of birth is unknown, the month and day subfields should contain zeros. The year subfield, if known, should be indicated but may be reported as 00's.

Must be in CCYYMMDD format.

Must be eight (8) numeric characters. First four (4) characters indicate year, the next two (2) characters indicate the month, and the last two (2) characters indicate the day.

The month subfield must be 00 to 12.

The day subfield must be 00 to 28, 29, 30 or 31 depending on the number of days in the month.

The year subfield must be four (4) digits.

**DEFINITION** See Appendix B (State Codes) and Appendix C (Country Codes).

**VALID CODES** Only the valid codes listed in Appendices B and C may be used.

**FIELD RESTRICTIONS** This field must indicate either a 2-character state code (example: AZ, CA); or a 2-character country code (example: Canada = CD; Mexico = MM).

Note: some countries have codes that are completely unlike the spelling (example: Russia/USSR = SX; Zaire = AR).

<b>VALID CODES</b>	Y = person is a U.S. citizen N = person is <i>not</i> a U.S. citizen U = unknown
<b>FIELD RESTRICTIONS</b>	Only the valid codes listed above may be used.

<b>DEFINITION</b>	This data element has multiple fields.
<b>VALID CODES</b>	See field restrictions below.
<b>FIELD RESTRICTIONS</b>	Values cannot be less than 001010001. The first three digits cannot be all zeroes. Social Security Numbers beginning with 9 indicate a non-resident alien.

<b>DEFINITION</b>	This field indicates whether a subject has been previously incarcerated in the Arizona Department of Corrections (DOC). An incarcerated individual keeps that number for life. Once a number is assigned to an individual, that number is not available to be re-assigned to a different individual.
<b>VALID CODES</b>	Only inmate numbers assigned by the Arizona Department of Corrections may be used.  Alpha characters indicate 1 <sup>st</sup> commitment ( <b>A</b> ); 2 <sup>nd</sup> commitment ( <b>B</b> ); 3 <sup>rd</sup> commitment ( <b>C</b> ), etc.
<b>FIELD RESTRICTIONS</b>	Only inmate numbers assigned by the Arizona Department of Corrections may be used.

**FIELD RESTRICTIONS** Eliminate dual addresses where possible.

The Attention line is placed above the Recipient line. For example, the ATTN John Doe line is above the line indicating ABC Company.

Punctuation may be eliminated in the delivery address.

Spell out City Names in their entirety. For example, the City of W. Stockbridge would be spelled out "West Stockbridge."

Slashes and hyphens may be used. For example, 101 W Loma Vista Dr; or 289-01 Howe St.
