**Brainstorm List of Projects by Area:**

LJ – e-citation (3 ways – handhelds/MDCs, DPS vans, other photo devices); AZTEC update to support auto-opening cases (1.4), streamlining mass adoption of e-citation statewide; form-based filing by pro se litigants using standard form data; bulk FED case initiation in Encanto Justice

GJ – Multi-vendor model proof of concept; interactive forms at superior courts; destruction of paper, MC EDMS/filing system enhancements; OnBase implementation progress in rural courts

Appellate – EDMS implementations in Div One and Supreme Court; court to court filing of record on appeal; litigant to court e-filing portal and criminal filing in Supreme Court; Appellation CMS modifications to support e-filing
